Mr. Sandy Wai-Yan Chau is a very successful entrepreneur doing business in Vietnam, Taiwan, Hong Kong, China and the United States. Mr. Chau has been active in Silicon Valley engaging in IT, semiconductor and traditional high tech business investments since 1990, and has concentrated most his investments in Biotech since 2006. Currently, Mr. Chau is the Managing Director of Acorn Campus Ventures and the Founder and Managing Partner of Suma Venture Capital. Prior to high tech, his business included a wide range of industries such as food, chemical products, robotic, real estate, department store/retail and construction materials. In fact, Mr. Chau was the CEO of one of the largest and most diversified listed construction and real estate firms in Taiwan between 1992 and 1997. Mr. Chau began his career in the United States as head of a consulting firm for start-ups in the San Francisco Bay Area. He was the Founding President of the influential Asian American Manufacturing Association (AAMA) in Silicon Valley in 1979, and in 1977 started Universal Semiconductor in San Jose, California. Since 1984, he has been actively involved in various real estate projects in the U.S. and Far East. He has a BS in chemical engineering from the University of California, Berkeley and an MBA.
