William Wang is the CEO and founder of VIZIO, Inc. A native of Taiwan, William came to the U.S. with his family at age 12 and later graduated from USC with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering. A great example of a “visionary serial entrepreneur,” Wang started MAG Innovision at age 26, Princeton Graphic Systems at age 34, and eventually VIZIO Inc. in 2002.

Wang has guided the company to its present status as producer of the top-selling brand of HDTVs in the U.S. In 2008, VIZIO was ranked #1 on the Inc. “500 Top Companies in Computers and Electronics” list in 2008 and one of Fast Company’s “Top 10 Most Innovative Consumer Electronics Companies” for two consecutive years (2009, 2010). Wang has also been personally recognized and received many awards including Ernst & Young’s “Entrepreneur of the Year” (2008) and The Orange County Business Journal’s “Business Person of the Year” (2010).

Headquartered in Irvine, California, VIZIO skyrocketed to the top by becoming the #1 selling brand of flat panel HDTVs in North America and the first American brand in over a decade to lead in U.S. TV sales.
